**BACKGROUND:** The purpose of this project is to provide safety improvements and improve traffic flow for the intersections of Dallas Highway at Poplar Springs Road / Holland Road and Old Dallas Road at Holland Road.

**PROJECT LIMITS:** The limits of the Project extend along Dallas Highway from the northern terminus of the existing intersection with Poplar Springs Road to the southern terminus of the existing intersection with Old Dallas Road.

**PROJECT LENGTH:** The length of this project is less than 1 mile.

**PROJECT SCOPE:** The project consists of combining two separate intersections into one intersection to improve safety and capacity throughout the project corridor. The intersections of Poplar Springs Road @ Dallas Highway and Holland Road @ Dallas Highway will be realigned to form one intersection with both Poplar Springs Road and Holland Road intersecting Dallas Highway at 90° angles. The old roads of Holland Road and Poplar Springs Road will be removed. Also, the intersection of Old Dallas Road @ Holland Road will be realigned to a 4-way, stop-controlled intersection with the portion of Holland Road to the south of Old Dallas Road being shifted to the east to align with the northern portion of Holland Road which is also being shifted to the east.
