

COBB COUNTY AIRPORT - MCCOLLUM FIELD
FEBRUARY 2008 UPDATE INFORMATION
NO MEETING HELD

1. Control Tower

a. Operations

Traffic count for January was 9,371. Take off and landings were 48% above last January.

b. ATC Manager's Report

The Control Tower will be distributing its Annual Customer Survey and requests your feedback. This feedback has been very helpful in the past in identifying areas for improvements.

2. Airport Capital Projects

a. Taxiway A Rehabilitation/Stormwater Piping Project

The Stormwater Piping and Taxiway A rehabilitation projects are continuing. A construction advisory NOTAM is in place. Expect extended closures of Taxiway A as work progresses. The contract time is through March but may very well be extended due to the delays that are the result of the continued wet conditions.

b. Runway Improvement Project

A meeting will be scheduled towards the end of February for FBO/SASOs to review the draft construction phasing plans that will be bid. The updated bid package will include multiple phasing schedules and bidding elements to provide the best opportunity to keep the bids as low as possible.

c. Control Tower Equipment

Information is being gathered to create a comprehensive bid document for new control tower equipment, if funding becomes available.

3. FAA Projects

a. Draft New ILS Approach for Widened Runway

The FAA must draft a new ILS Rnwy 27 Approach because the localizer antennas will be shifted by 12.5'. New staff has been assigned to the office that prepares the Procedures. All the information necessary has either been sent or resent to keep the process moving forward.

4. Old Business

a. Aesthetic Upgrades

The airport continues to focus on upgrading the aesthetics of the airport. A consultant is being hired to assist in the project.

If anyone has a suggestion of an aesthetic improvement for RYY please forward the idea to Von Hagel for consideration. If you are familiar with an airport worth modeling the improvements after please forward the airport's name. Only two suggestions have been received to date: Santa Monica Airport, Ca. and MidCoast Regional Airport, Ga.

b. Statistics / Economic Impact Study

The request for end of the year statistics from the airport commercial operators has not resulted in enough responses to adequately complete an economic impact study. SASOs, please consider submitting the information requested.
